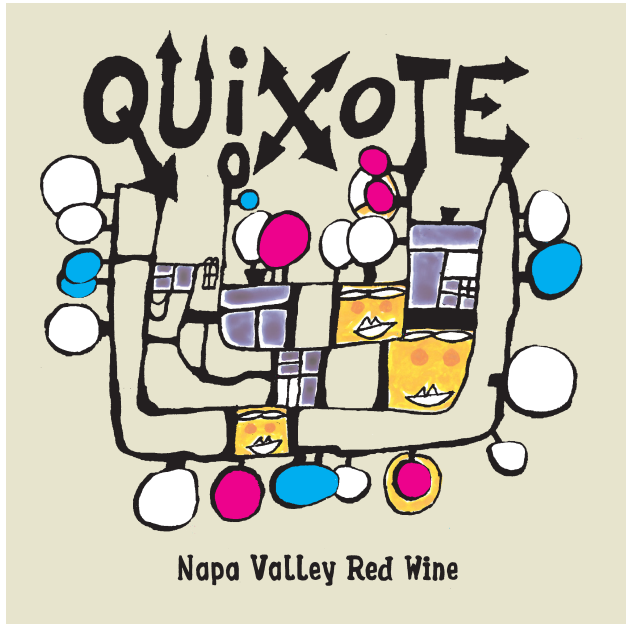


2001 Quixote Cabernet Sauvignon
