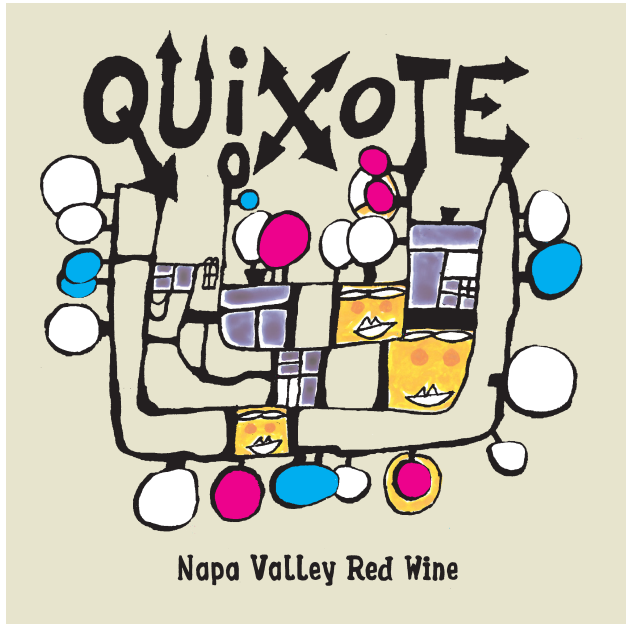


2001 Quixote Petite Syrah
